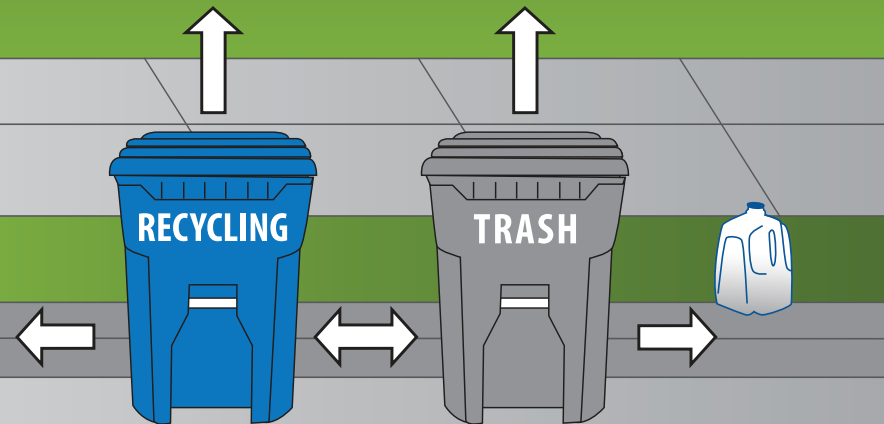


# Cart Placement Guide

- Place carts at least 3 ft. away from other carts or objects.
- Give at least 14 ft. clearance above cart from low branches.
- Make sure cart handle faces house.
- Place used motor oil and jugs in plain view of drivers.

# Trash Guidelines

- Trash and recycling must be set out by 7:00 a.m. Place carts 3 ft. from other carts or objects (fire hydrants, mailboxes, cars, utility poles) with the handle towards house. Do not block sidewalks.
- All residents will receive a 95-gallon trash cart for automated pick-up.
- Weight limits: 95 gallon carts – 200 lbs.
- Place used motor oil jugs in plain view of drivers. (Up to 2 gallons per week.)
- Seasonal composting - Fall leaf and Christmas tree collection curbside!

## BULKY WASTE & APPLIANCES

Allied Waste provides appliance, furniture and other large item collection for an additional fee. All bulky items must be outside and visible to the driver. When applicable, Freon is safely removed from appliances before they are recycled. To arrange for a special pickup call (208) 345.1265.

## CARRY-OUT SERVICE

Customers who have qualified for temporary or permanent disabilities under the Americans with Disabilities Act may receive free carry-out service. Other customers may sign up for carry-out service for a small fee. For more information call (208) 345.1265

# Hazardous Waste & Prohibited Material

All hazardous materials should be taken to the Ada County landfill including: fluorescent tubes, CFL bulbs, paint, stain, varnish, computer monitors, televisions, tires, vehicle batteries, gasoline, oil, pesticides, and herbicides.

## PROHIBITED MATERIAL

Explosives, ammunition, radioactive items, and biomedical waste are not accepted. **DON'T** place loose sharps (needles, syringes, lancets) in trash or recycling bins.

# Recycling Guidelines

- Recycling pick-up occurs on your trash day **EVERY OTHER WEEK.** For collection dates visit the calendar online at [www.alliedwasteidaho.com](http://www.alliedwasteidaho.com)
- All residents will receive a 95-gallon no-sort recycling cart (65-gallon available upon request)
- No need to separate recyclables
- The materials you can recycle will remain the same
- No curbside glass recycling
- No styrofoam, yard waste or glass in the recycling cart
- Additional recycling carts available for \$1.50 per cart per month

## FALL LEAF RECYCLING

The third week of November leaves in compostable paper leaf bags will be collected.

## TREE RECYCLING

Christmas trees are recycled the first full week of January each year. Cut trees and branches into 4 ft. pieces, bundle and place curbside on collection day. Strip ornaments, tinsel, lights and strands before recycling. Flocked trees and wreaths are not accepted.

- Cardboard boxes (must fit in container)
- Frozen food & Cereal boxes (no plastic film or liners)
- Construction paper
- Envelopes (celophane windows okay)
- Office waste paper (any color)
- Magazines & Catalogs
- Computer & fax paper
- Phone books
- Newspapers
- Paper bags
- Junk mail

## PLASTICS:

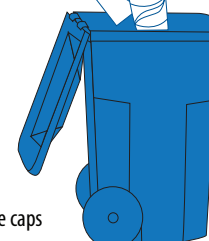
- Rigid Plastics #1-7 (no bags)
- Plastic bottles
- Dairy containers
- Yogurt cups
- Frozen food trays

## CANS:

- Aluminum, Steel, Tin, and Empty Aerosol Cans
- Cans must be empty
- Labels are okay

## NO:

- > styrofoam/packaging
- > chip and candy wrappers
- > hazardous waste containers
- > food contaminated paper (pizza boxes, plates, coffee cups)
- > wax coated cardboard
- > glass
- > yard waste
- > plastic bags
- > plastic bottle caps
- > milk & juice cartons
- > tissues, napkins, paper towels
